

















**Tour 1** 🚌 **2 hrs** **Prague - Historical City**

A visit to a majestic gothic castle built 650 years ago on a picturesque site in the middle of dense forests, about one hour drive from Prague. For many visitors this is one of the most popular destinations. After the visit of the castle, a traditional Czech lunch will be served in the restaurant Bohemia. A special menu for vegetarians, diabetics and children is available. The price includes entry to the castle and lunch.

### Konopiste Chateau and Brewery Velke Popovice

#### A CULTURAL EXCURSION AND BEER TASTING

The Konopiště chateau is about 45 km out of Prague. It was founded in the 14th century and in 1887 it was renovated by the successor to the Habsburg throne, František Ferdinand d'Este, who was assassinated in Sarajevo in 1914, starting the World War I. The chateau is famous for its fascinating collection of weapons and hunting trophies. After visiting the chateau, we will take you to a renowned brewery in Velké Popovice where you get a chance to see how the Czech favourite beer is made.



### Tour 10



6 hrs

### Kutná Hora (Ossuary - Bone Church - incl.)

#### UNESCO WORLD CULTURAL AND NATURAL HERITAGE

The picturesque medieval town of Kutná Hora, part of the UNESCO World Cultural and Natural Heritage, is situated approximately 60 km east of Prague. The sources of the beauties and riches of Kutná Hora are in the silver mines that were exploited most intensively in the 14th and 15th century. At that time the town rivalled Prague itself in importance. During this excursion you will see interesting and most impressive sights as the unique Gothic Cathedral of St. Barbara, the patron of saint miners, the nearby Hrádek building which has a direct relationship with the town's mining past, Wallachian Court (Vlašský dvůr) which is an important building, originally a Royal Mint, that once produced Prague groschen as well. Then you will see the Gothic fountain, and the Archdeacon's Church of St. James.



**Tour 11****10 hrs****Cesky Krumlov****UNESCO WORLD CULTURAL AND NATURAL HERITAGE**

We invite you to visit the picturesque medieval town of Český Krumlov, located in scenic Southern Bohemia along the banks of River Vltava. The Town was founded in 13th century and has retained its former medieval character. Český Krumlov castle is the second largest in the country after Prague castle. It was a seat of the powerful Rozmberk and Schwarzenberg families and now houses rich historical collections. In the castle gardens you cannot miss the unique 18th century castle theatre. You will also have time to have a rest in one of the many stylish and cosy pubs.

**Tour 12****3 hrs****Prague by night****ENJOY THE NIGHT PRAGUE FROM BUS AND BOAT**

Would you like to be fascinated by Prague's history and atmosphere much more than up to now? Choose this night tour to spend an enjoyable evening. First of all we will take you by bus for a short city tour through the Old and the New Town. Then our tour will continue by boat along the Vltava River. During the three hours cruise you will admire the most remarkable sights of the Old Town, the Lesser Town and the Prague Castle passing also the Charles Bridge and Vyšehrad. This river cruise includes also a music entertainment as well as a buffet dinner that will be served on the board. The tour ends at 22:00 at the boat pier Na Frantisku in the Old Town.

**Tour 13****11 hrs****Dresden - Germany****SAXONY FLORENCE ON THE ELBE RIVER**

Take a trip with us to the well-known „Zwinger“ Art Gallery where you can admire „Sixtin Madonna“, the famous picture by Raffael, as well as many notable works by the Old Masters of centuries 14–17 (Rubens, Rembrandt, Poussin etc.). The admission fee to Zwinger is included. The historical city centre is best to be walked through on foot. You should not forget to taste a special home-made „Eierschecke“ cake in some of cosy Dresden cafes. Every hour you may take a ride through a city centre on a historic steamer-ship. Departure from Dresden: 17:30 - Schauspielhaus, Ostra-Alle 2. Arrival to Prague: 20:00. Please do not forget your passport with you.

**Tour 14****15 hrs****Vienna - Austria****THE CAPITAL OF AUSTRIA**

We invite you to take a trip with us to one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites, to Vienna. This city located on the Danube River is considered to be a town of music, historical sights, museums and shopping. The journey takes about 3 1/2 hours depending on the traffic on the D1 highway. In Vienna you will arrive directly at the well-known public amusement park „Prater“. You will recognise it thanks to its famous Giant Ferris Wheel, which offers an amazing view of the city. Our bus will wait here until the evening to take you back to Prague. To get to the very city centre you will take metro line U1 from the station „Praterstern“ to the station „STEPHANPLATZ“ (the 3rd station in the direction of REUMANNPLATZ). If you are keen on shopping, do not forget to visit the „Mariahilfer Strasse“, which is well-known for its numerous shops and boutiques. And you should definitely take your time to taste a renowned „Sacher“ cake in one of local cafes. From the city centre back to the station „Praterstern“ you will take the metro line U1 in the direction of „LEOPOLDAU“.

You can visit there the company's shop where you can buy crystal products at reasonable prices. And moreover – each of guests will get a small present.
